About the Louisiana Chamber of Commerce Foundation

The Louisiana Chamber of Commerce Foundation is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization established in 2018 to help drive the economic growth of Louisiana by empowering and sustaining the BIPOC business community through the development of local chambers. This mission is achieved by engaging public and private sector partners across Louisiana to provide BIPOC businesses with technical assistance to build their capacity and prepare them to access procurement opportunities, a strong network of BIPOC chambers of commerce and advocacy for BIPOC business growth and development. LCCF's influence is felt throughout the state as an economic development organization dedicated to the establishment, development, growth, expansion, and sustainability of Louisiana's BIPOC-owned businesses.

Through its Chanber of Commerce Growth Initiative (CCGI) program LCCF supports BIPOC chambers and advances equitable economic development for BIPOC-owned businesses. The Business Innovation Program (BIP) delivers a variety of technial support and training in business development, planning, management and leadership to BIPOC business owners to mitigate common barriers to success. BIP clients learn about and receive support with business planning, human resources, legal issues impacting small business owners, insurance, contracts and procurement, accounting and finance and digital marketing/e-commerce. LCCF also serves as a liaison and connector between Louisiana's BIPOC business community and state and municipal agencies whose focus is policy, outreach, and/or small business utilization.

LCCF has quickly established itself as the go-to resource for BIPOC business development and growth in Louisiana. Entering into a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement (CEA) with the State of Louisiana through Louisiana Economic Development (LED) in 2019, LCCF worked to extend the reach of LED's Small Business Programming into the BIPOC business community; through which LCCF has engaged hundreds of BIPOC-owned businesses and strengthened BIPOC chambers of commerce. LCCF also recently worked with the Louisiana State Treasurer, guiding the design of the state's Main Street Recovery Program affording minority business enterprises (MBEs) an exclusive application period, during which MBEs had access to the first \$40M of COVID economic relief grants from the Louisiana State Treasurer's office. In 2021, the organization received funding to support the expansion of its BIP to senior-aged small business owners across the state. LCCF secured its first federal grant from the Economic Development Administration in the Spring of 2022 to support the start-up of a business incubator that supports BIPOC-owned small businesses in Lake Charles. LCCF is paving the way for innovative approaches to BIPOC business development and sustainability in the future.








Addressing the growing need
